Despite the huge influx of day trippers, beautiful Porquerolles somehow remains unspoilt. Two-thirds of its sandy white beaches, pine woods, maquis and eucalyptus are protected by the Parc National de Port-Cros, and a wide variety of indigenous and tropical flora thrive, including Requier's larkspur, which grows nowhere else in the world. The southern edge of the island is the most dramatic and uncluttered, but the inland vineyards and olive groves have a magic of their own, as do the gorgeous beaches of the northern coast.

Porquerolles boasts a fantastic restaurant called Mas du Longostier, it is truly worthy of its Michelin stars with the magical setting and unrivalled cuisine. Gaze over the sea which is an utterly striking spectrum of blue, enjoy the silence as cars are banned on this islands.

Take a morning cruise to Porquerolles for idyllic beaches and clear waters. Take a tour of the island by bicycle island before enjoying a delicious dinner at l'Olivier in le Mas du Langoustier.





# CANNES

Now the focal point is the famous Hotel Eden Roc, which is packed with stars during the Cannes Film Festival.

Famous for its July Jazz Festival, Juan les Pins is a lively summer spot just along from Antibes. You'll find a narrow stretch of beach with a variety of restaurants, a promenade with boutiques and hotels, and a park shaded by perfumed pine trees.

# SAINT-JEAN-CAP-FERRAT






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
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### SAINT-JEAN-CAP-FERRAT

The peninsula of St Jean Cap Ferrat encompasses every ounce of luxury associated with the French Riviera while also managing to emanate a sense of tranquility amongst the summer hedonism. As superyachts purr in the port and the world's most expensive properties line gated residential areas, St Jean Cap Ferrat is about as exclusive as it gets. Fully-equipped to offer the glamour and amenities to a discerning crowd, the remarkably unspoilt scenery of this forested stretch between Nice and Monaco has long attracted everyone from aristocracy to billionaires.

Between the port of St Jean Cap Ferrat and the southern tip of the Cap is wild and remote to offer a few hours of morning respite from the dizzying luxury of this part of the world, as is the shaded walk from Beaulieu. There are also plenty of sun-kissed coves and sheltered bays to find along the 15km coastal stretch along with a handful of low-key eateries. Spend the afternoon visiting the stunning Villa Kerylos or Villa Ephrussi de Rothschild and sample the famous Bouillabaise in Villefranche sur Mer at La Mère Germaine.
