

SOFT BEACHES AND WINDING VALLEYS

The nuptial isle of Dionysos, God of wine and ecstasy, and a place where the beauty of its scenery is matched only by the charm of its traditional villages, Naxos invites visitors into a world of Greek culture and captivating Mediterranean atmosphere. The island is dominated by the imposing and aptly named Mount Zeus, a 1004m high peak that forms the heart of the interior, covered in verdant green forests and enchanting villages. The charismatic capital of Chora is a bustling harbour town situated on the picturesque west coast and is known as one of the most beautiful in the region.

One of the biggest appeals of Naxos to charter guests is its glorious southwest-facing coast which is lined with exceptional stretches of sand that almost create one entire long beach, separated only by little headlands. It is here you will find beaches famous for their beauty and plentiful enough to find both secluded coves and busy summer spots such as Plaka, Agios Prokopios and Orkos. The western coastline meanwhile is perfect for adrenaline junkies looking to make full use of the toys on board your superyacht as the strong winds in the afternoon create ideal conditions for kite surfing and wind surfing.

Santorini's iconic bright white buildings that tumble down the cliff-sides provide some of the most picturesque backdrops in the world and are best seen approaching from the sea from the decks of a superyacht. A visit to the bustling main village of Fira offers a colourful display of traditional Greek gyros and an atmospheric piazza as well as a cosmopolitan collection of bars and clubs that boasts captivating views over the Caldera.

After cruising from Amorgos to Santorini, you will spend the day here on the white sandy beaches with their crystal clear blue waters. In the evening you will move on to Santotini Island where you will anchor overnight. There is plenty to see and do here, including an excursion to the beautiful paths of Thira, the capital. Sunsets on the island are particularly striking; all the restaurants and bars in Fira face west over the sunken volcano and the Aegean Sea, awaiting the famous Santorini Sunset.


CHARMING AND UNSPOILED

Folegandros features a traditional Island atmosphere, cosy small villages and breathtaking views. The landscape is varied and includes tall cliffs and a large cave. The capital of the Island Chora, is built on the edge of a 200 meter high cliff. While the island's amenities may not have been gentrified - only adding to its charm - there are a number of good restaurants and bars to enjoy on an evening ashore. The main town Hora is home to most of these but in the smaller rural villages of Karavostassis and Ano Merià you'll also find small traditional taverns with fantastic local dishes on offer.

There are also some good hiking trails worth exploring into the hills, where you can enjoy the scents of thyme and oregano in the spring before heading back to your luxury charter yacht to relax with some sundowners to experience one of the famous Greek island sunsets. Overall its quiet charm and self-assured, unspoilt offerings create an atmosphere that you'll want to visit over and again.
